



Gaining electrical mechanic endorsement

The requirements to gain the endorsement of Electrical Mechanic are 12 months work experience under supervision and successful completion of the Capstone test.

An Electrical Fitter who wants to gain the additional endorsement of Electrical Mechanic should follow the following process:

- Lodge application [Form 12](#) - **Application for Additional Endorsement on A Grade Licence** with the Board.
- If the application is in order the Board issues the applicant a permit to enable 12 months electrical installation work experience to be gained.
- The work experience must be gained, after the permit has been issued, under the supervision of an A Grade Electrical Mechanic.
- On completion of the work experience, the Capstone test must be completed at the Board-approved Registered Training Organisation (RTO).
- The applicant lodges evidence of the twelve months electrical installation work experience.
- The applicant advises the Board of the results of the Capstone test.
- If all the above conditions are met satisfactorily, the application is approved and the applicant is requested to return the Electrical Fitters licence and a new licence is issued.

Note:

It is imperative that the above steps are followed as gaining experience without a permit and without supervision, is in effect, working unlicensed. The employer would also be in breach of the Act for employing an unlicensed worker.
